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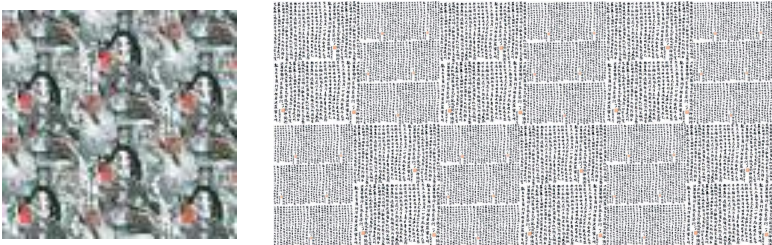
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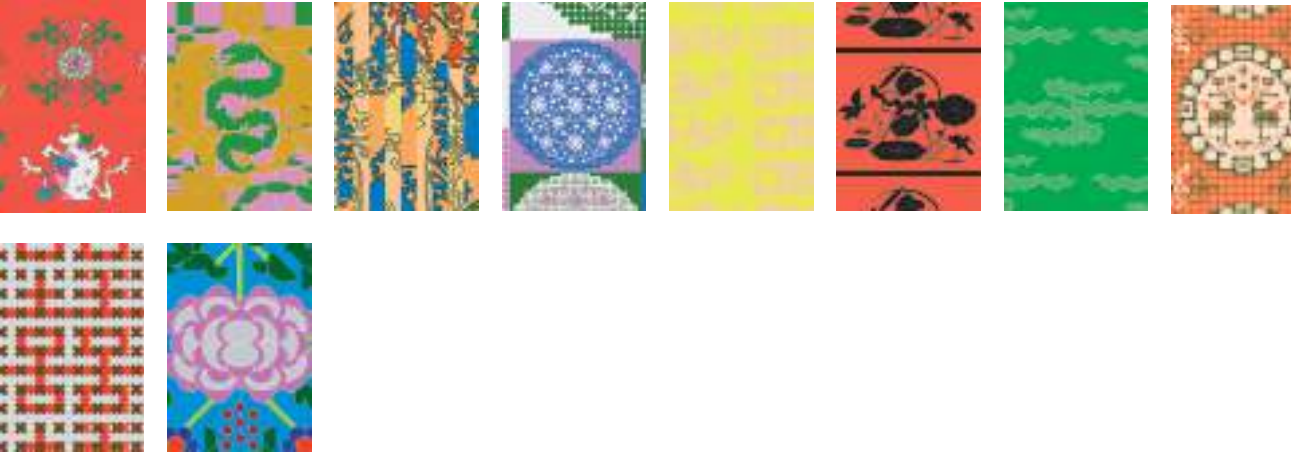

Hide & Seek Chinese Zodiac Pattern 中國生肖捉迷藏圖案

This maximalist print playfully embodies the *joie de vivre* of SHANGHAI TANG with a touch of contemporary *chinoiserie*. Look for the 12 Chinese Zodiac animals camouflaged amidst swirling blooms of floral and paisley.

City of Double Happiness Pattern 雙喜城圖案

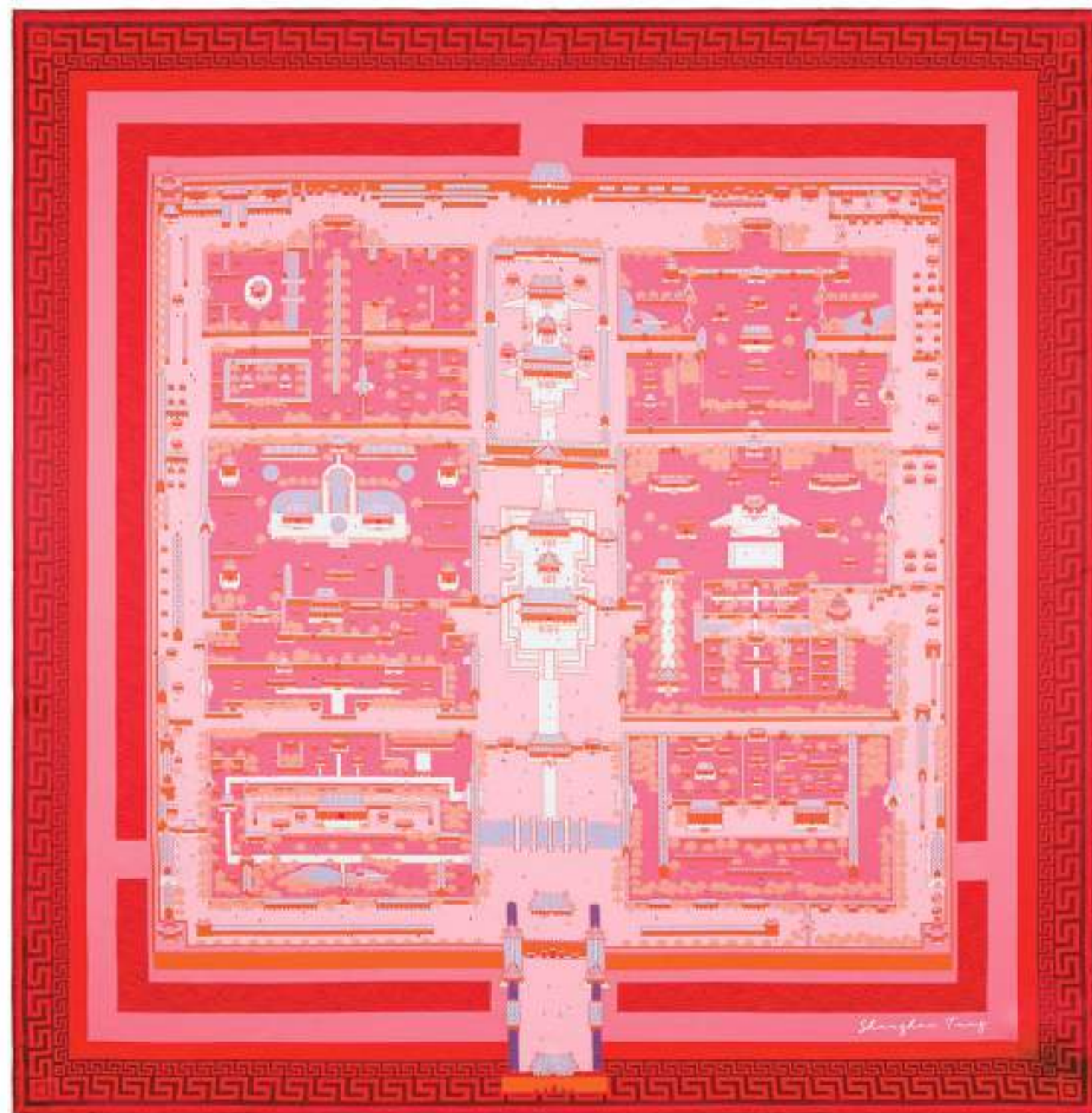
Celebrate the timeless elegance of SHANGHAI TANG and its spirit of *joie de vivre* with this Double Happiness pattern. This design combines the traditional Chinese character *Xi*, bestowing the wish for abundant joy, with architectural motifs from the Forbidden City. Geometric forms artfully filled with landscape details, are surrounded by alternating borders of art deco patterns and auspicious waves.

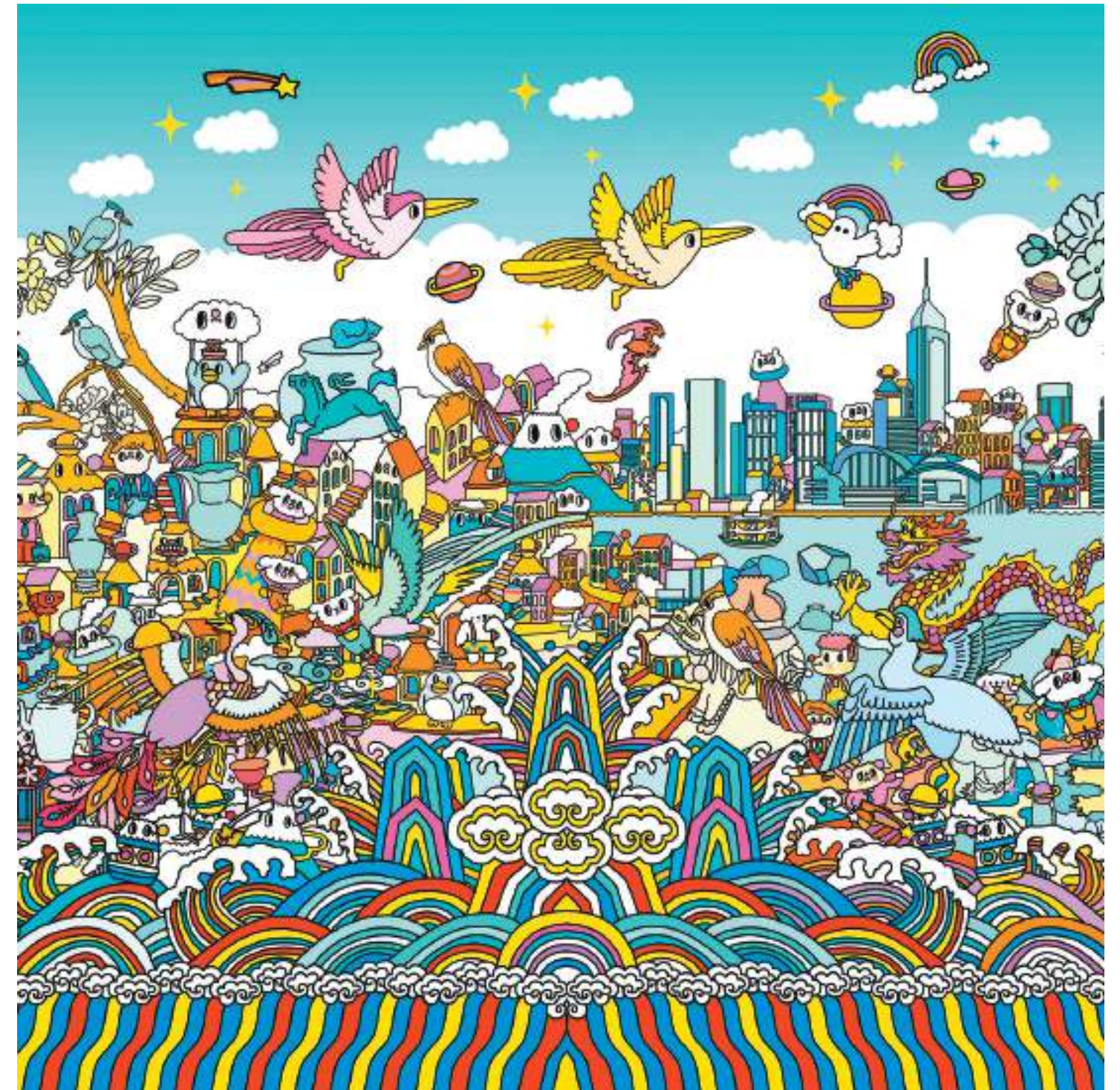

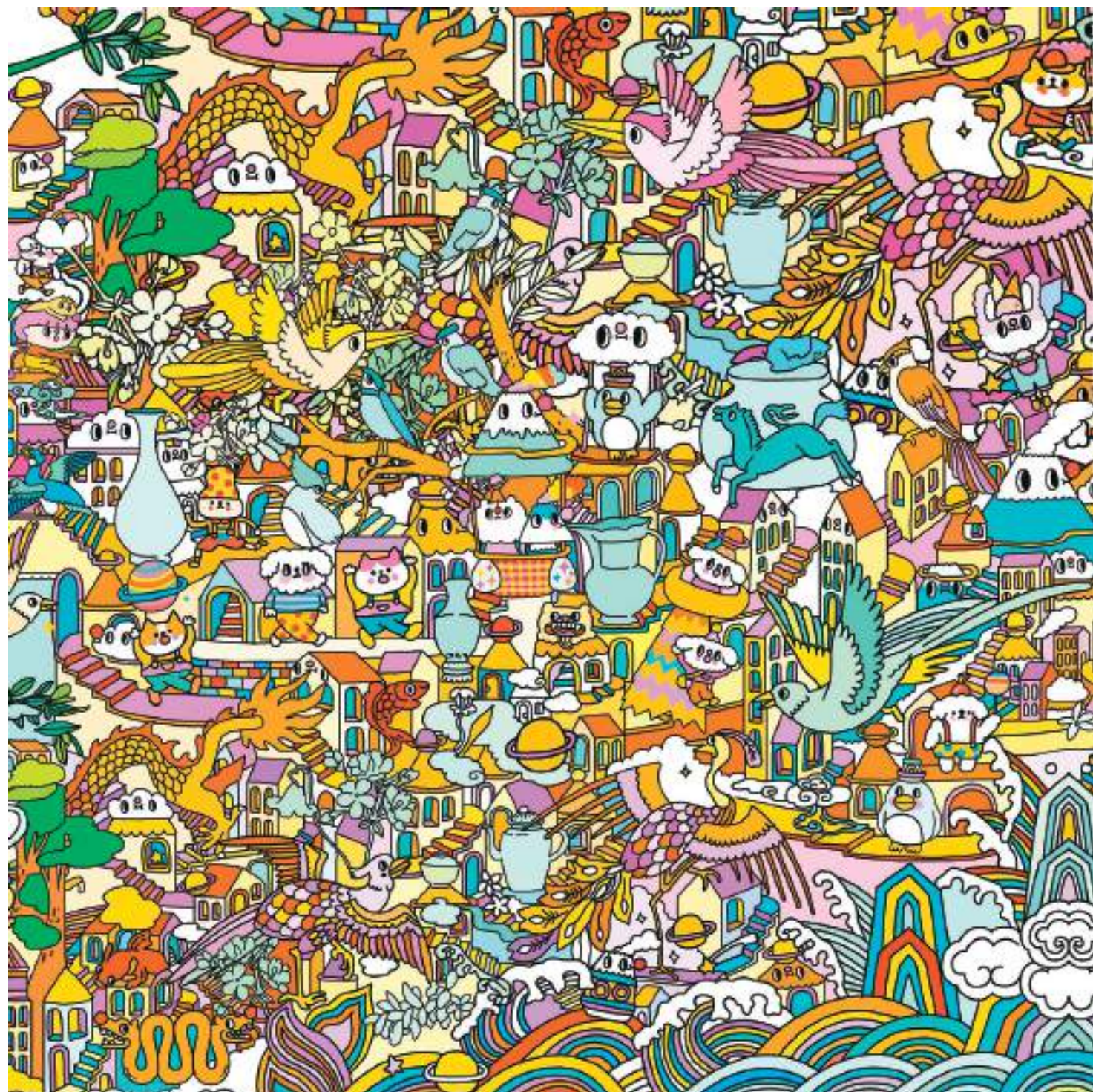

RATIONALE OF PATTERNS

圖案設計的理念

Badu Hemp Embroidery is an ancient folk craft that originated during the Three Kingdoms period (220-280 AD), primarily found in the Badu area of Zhejiang Province. Applied to the woven hemp cloth of commoners, the embroidered designs feature continuous lines symbolising "uninterrupted continuity."

In 2007, this embroidery was listed as an intangible cultural heritage in Zhejiang Province, and in 2011, it was recognised as an endangered craft in Hangzhou. The Textile Library has decided to reinterpret this traditional craft, creating a series of products incorporating the Mahjong-inspired theme.

Pattern 24007 & 24008 feature Mahjong tiles stacked like shards of porcelain.

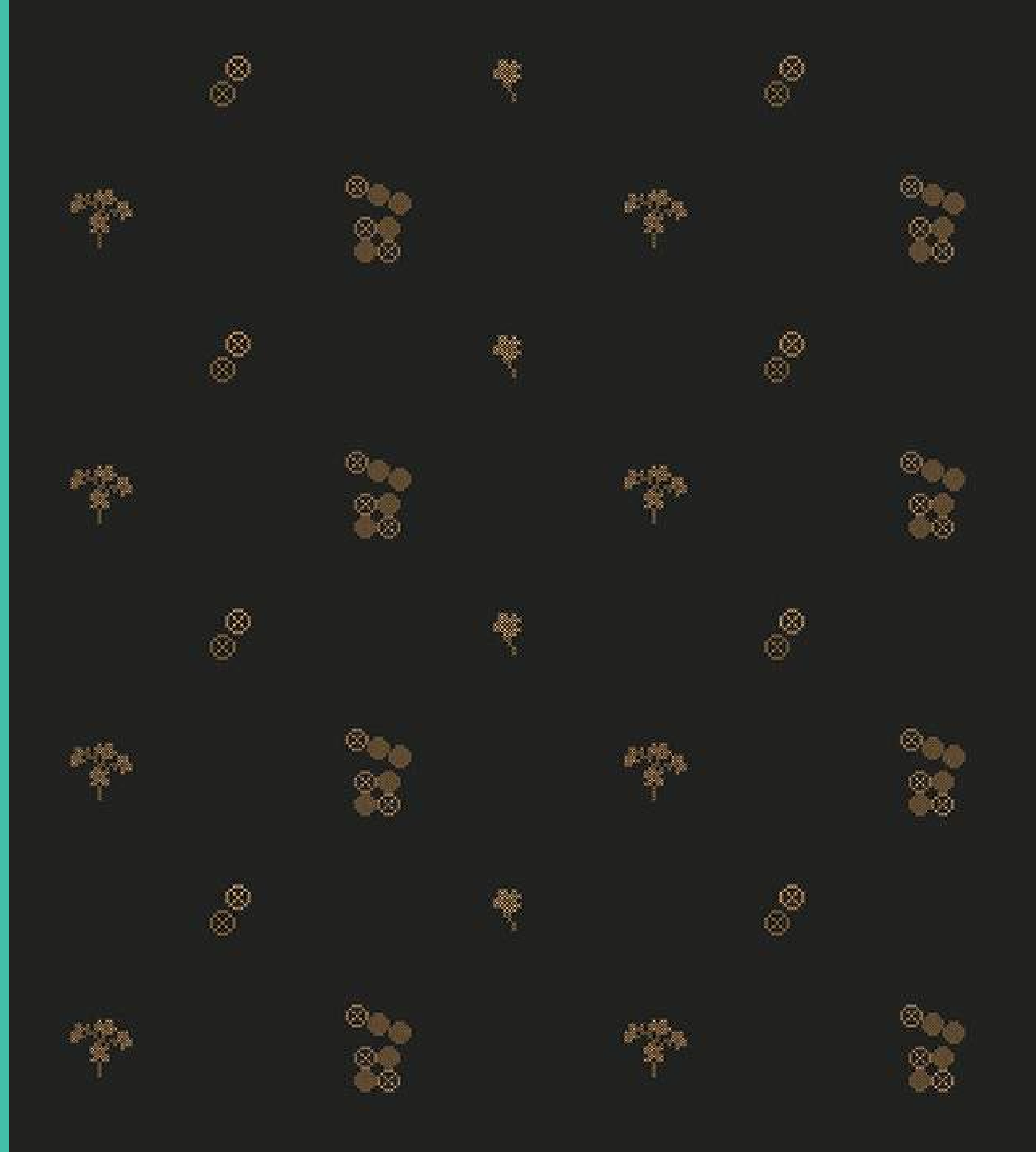
Pattern 24005 & 24006 play with the graphics on Mahjong tiles, presented in Badu iconic cross stitches, portraying a sense of modernity.

八都麻繡是一項具有悠久歷史的民間藝術，起源於三國時期，主要分布在浙江淳安八都一帶。最初，麻繡用於製作日常生活中的漢麻織品。圖案的線條從起針到收針無間斷，象徵著「連綿不斷，九九歸一」。

2007 年，八都麻繡被列入浙江省非物質文化遺產名錄，2011 年被杭州市列為瀕危項目。布料圖書館在訪問當地後，決定對這項傳統技藝進行解讀，並創作出一系列以八都麻繡為靈感的產品，結合麻將，探索圖案、布料及相關衍生品。

圖案 24007 及 24008 是受到麻將桌上堆疊感的啟發，融合中國瓷器的碎片形態進行拼接。

圖案 24005 及 24006 則提取麻將上的「二筒」和「七筒」圖案，並以八都麻繡的「回」繡法進行創作。

Kowloon 九龍

Kowloon, a densely populated area in the heart of Hong Kong, is a transliteration of two Chinese characters meaning 'nine dragons'. Our dragon motif is an interpretation of the hustle and bustle of Hong Kong.

Heart Sutra 心經

The Heart Sutra is a printed classic within the Mahāyāna Buddhist tradition. In Sanskrit, it is known as *Prajñāpāramitāhṛdaya*.

A notable line from the Sutra states: 'Form is emptiness, emptiness is form'.

As a form of our creative expression, we seek to infuse our work with spirituality, inspiring our customers to adopt a more discerning approach to fashion consumption.

Alison Yip 葉鎧林

Alison Yip is a young jewellery designer and brand founder who returned to Hong Kong to study jewellery design after spending a year in France during her secondary school years. Her secondary school placed great emphasis on fostering students' creative thinking and personal development, laying the foundation for her future business venture. The idea of establishing her own brand came to her as early as Form 4, when she was studying. After learning practical jewellery design skills during her studies at the age of 21, she started her own brand, focusing on sterling silver jewellery, and won the first runner-up prize in a jewellery design competition organised by the Trade Development Council.

In her contribution to the Motifx design project, Alison reinterpreted traditional Chinese motifs in a way that blended Eastern and Western concepts. She draws inspiration from traditional motifs such as “Blue and White Porcelain” and “Phoenix in Peony” simplifying complex motifs into imagery and developing graphic concepts into three-dimensional jewellery pieces.

This experience not only deepened her understanding of traditional Chinese culture, but also broadened her design vision. Through studying the works of contemporary Chinese designers, she has learned the importance of preserving traditional characteristics in innovation and aims to create modern works that are instantly recognisable as Chinese.

葉鎧林（Alison Yip）是一位年輕的珠寶設計師及品牌創辦人。中學時期曾到法國交流一年，其後回港修讀珠寶設計。她所讀的中學著重培育學生的創意思維和個人發展，這為她日後創業奠定了重要基礎。早在中四時期，她便萌生了創立品牌的想法。在 21 歲求學期間，學習到實用的珠寶設計技術後，隨即創立了個人品牌，主力設計純銀首飾，更在貿易發展局舉辦的珠寶設計比賽中獲得亞軍。

在參與 Motifx 設計項目時，Alison 以中西合璧為創作理念，將中國傳統圖案重新演繹。她從《青花瓷》和《鳳穿牡丹圖》等傳統圖案汲取靈感，善於將複雜的圖案簡化成意象，並將平面設計發展成立體的首飾作品。

這次創作經驗不僅加深了她對中國傳統文化的認識，更擴闊了她的設計視野。通過研究當代中國設計師的作品，她領悟到在創新中保留傳統特色的重要性，期望日後能創作出既富現代感，又能讓觀眾輕易識別出當中中國元素的作品。



RATIONALE OF PATTERNS 圖案設計的理念

This design concept merges the Western style of nature painting with Chinese calligraphy. It features marigolds and orchids, along with butterflies and birds, to symbolise freedom and life with the blend in calligraphy to enrich the theme. This design aims to evoke emotional resonance, expressing a love for life and reverence for nature while fostering understanding and dialogue between Eastern and Western.

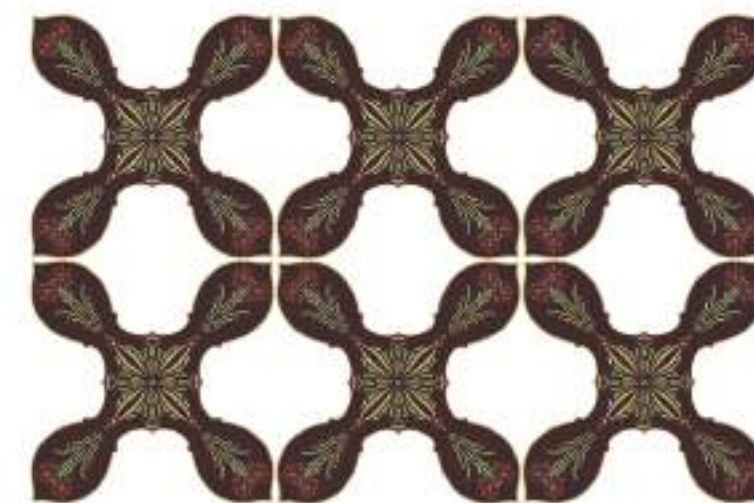
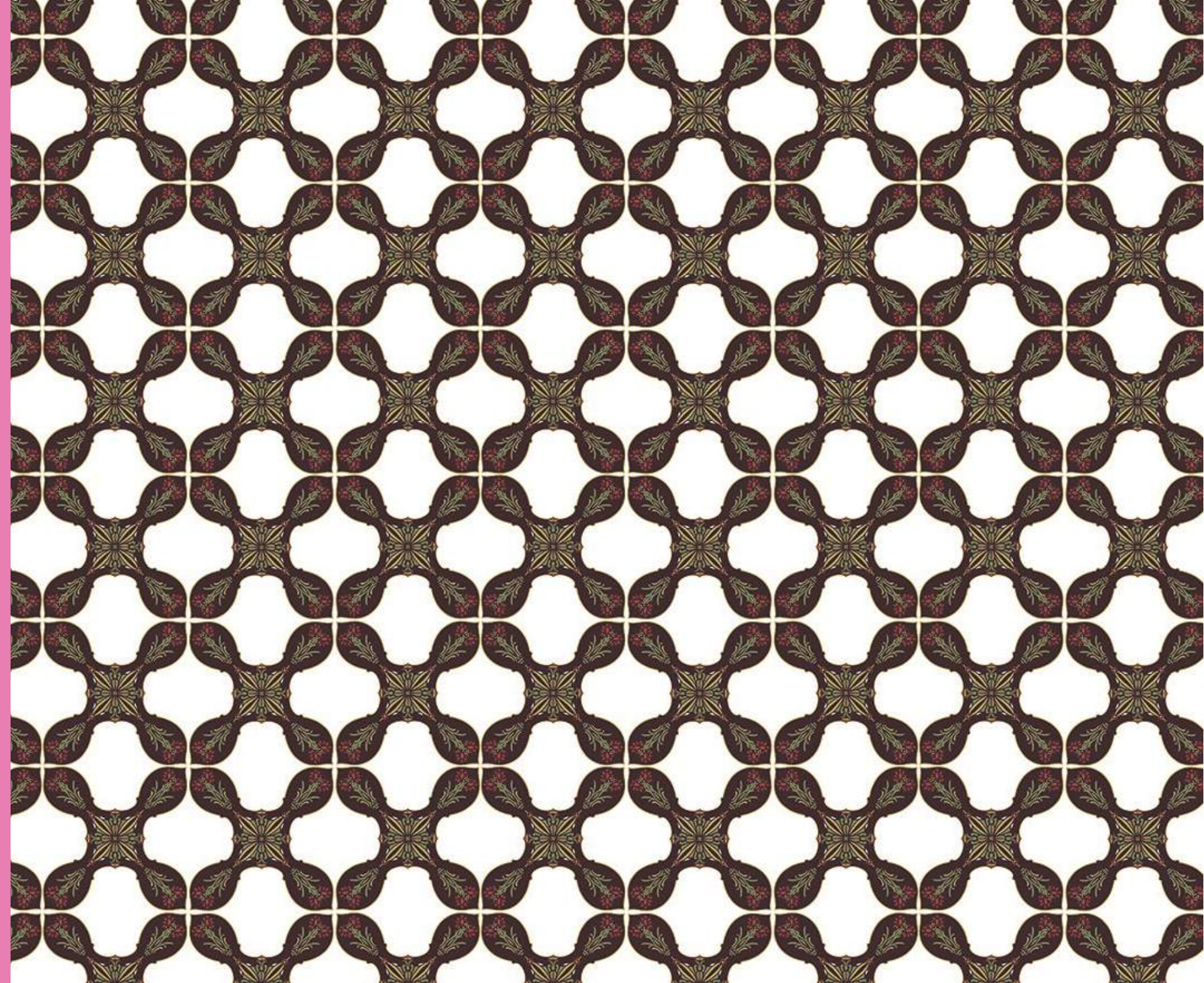
PERSONAL PROFILE 個人簡介

Eliz Chin 錢皓晴

New designer, Eliz Chin Ho Ching, currently studying for a Higher Diploma in Digital Fashion Branding and Merchandising at the Hong Kong Design Institute, states that the Motifx project was the catalyst for her interest in the history and culture of ancient China. Eliz created her **Flower and Butterfly Calligraphy** series by combining Chinese calligraphy with patterns.

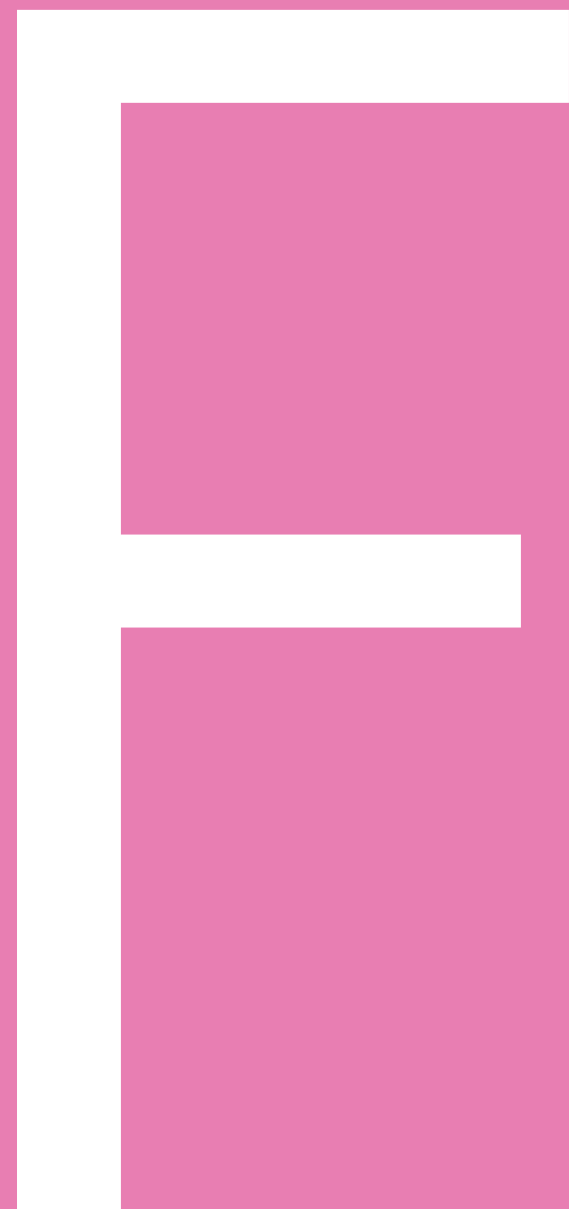
In the course of her research, Eliz sought to gain insight into the visual culture of various dynasties in China. She emphasised the design elements of the Tang Dynasty, such as the ornate floral and bird motifs, which served as the basis for her designs. Her objective is to demonstrate the versatility of traditional Chinese art through her contemporary and organic design approach. She particularly values the Ruyi and Begonia patterns from the Tang and Song dynasties, which she believes can be flexibly applied to different pattern designs with infinite variations.

This creative project has provided Eliz with a valuable opportunity to gain new insights. She acknowledges that her studies were primarily focused on Western culture, and that she had limited exposure to traditional Chinese art and culture. This project has allowed her to develop a deeper understanding of Chinese art and culture to recognise the rich cultural connotations associated with traditional Chinese patterns, such as the use of warm colours to symbolise good luck.

新晉設計師錢皓晴（Eliz Chin），目前就讀於香港知專設計學院的數碼時裝品牌及採購高級文憑課程。她坦言，正是因為參與 Motifx 這個創作項目，才激發了她探索中國古代的歷史文化的興趣。她結合中國書法與圖案，創作了她的花蝶書法系列。

在資料搜集的過程中，Eliz 努力了解中國各朝代的視覺文化。她特別提到唐代的設計元素，如華麗的花卉和小鳥圖案，這些都成為了她設計的靈感來源。她希望透過清新自然的設計風格，展現中國傳統藝術的另一種可能性。此外，她更特別欣賞唐宋時期的如意紋和海棠紋，認為這些元素能夠靈活運用在不同的圖案設計中，展現無限變化。

這次創作項目實在令 Eliz 獲得了新的體會。她坦言，在求學時期主要接觸西方文化，對中國傳統藝術文化的了解相對較少。然而，這次項目給了她一個寶貴的機會，讓她開始深入研究中國藝術文化。她更發現，中國傳統圖案不僅僅是裝飾，更蘊含豐富的文化內涵，例如暖色調的運用象徵吉祥如意。

PERSONAL PROFILE 個人簡介

Kinyan completed his Higher Diploma studies at Hong Kong Design Institute and then his undergraduate studies at Nottingham Trent University. He graduated with a Master's degree from the London College of Fashion. Kinyan founded Genau Studio in 2021, dedicated to the use and promotion of natural dyeing techniques. The following year, he launched his brand, Kinyan Lam, drawing on the techniques and research developed at Genau Studio, with a focus on creating ethically made, high-quality garments.

林健仁 Kinyan Lam

Kinyan Lam 林健仁

Fashion designer Kinyan Lam is the founder and designer of Genau Studio. Established two years ago, the studio specialises in the use of natural dyes and traditional craftsmanship in contemporary design. He has also created a brand under his own name, Kinyan Lam, which has been exhibited in Paris and Shanghai, and has recently opened a pop-up shop in Causeway Bay, Hong Kong.

Kinyan Lam places special emphasis on the integration of traditional craftsmanship with modern design. His clothing is designed to be easy to mix and match, incorporating elements of traditional craftsmanship, such as knot stitch and natural dyeing from Guizhou in the Mainland, into simplistic styles. He is currently working with rural villages in Guizhou to utilise local craftsmanship, which not only helps preserve tradition, but also creates economic opportunities for these remote communities.

His latest collection, entitled “I was one of the trees”, is inspired by the traditional customs of the Basha Miao village in Guizhou. The village has a custom of planting a cedar tree to accompany a child as he grows up; this tree will eventually become his coffin, with another tree planted in his memory after burial, thus embodying the belief in the cycle of life. Kinyan prefers graphic and childlike patterns, with black-and-white designs drawn in ink. His participation in this Motifx project is a continuation of this series.

Kinyan completed a Higher Diploma programme at the Hong Kong Design Institute before pursuing further studies in England, and after graduation, he completed an internship in Germany.

時裝設計師林健仁（Kinyan Lam）是 Genau Studio 的創辦人及設計師。工作室成立兩年以來，Kinyan 善於將天然染色和傳統工藝融入當代設計，並以自己名字創立品牌 Kinyan Lam。其作品曾在巴黎和上海展出，最近在香港銅鑼灣開設快閃店。

Kinyan 特別重視傳統工藝與現代設計的結合。他的服裝設計注重易於搭配，在簡約款式上加入傳統工藝元素，如貴州打籽繡和天然染色等。目前，他與貴州的農村合作，善用當地工藝，這不僅有助延續傳統，也為偏遠村落創造經濟收入。

他最新的系列以《I was one of the trees》為主題，靈感來自貴州岜沙苗寨的傳統習俗。該村落有種植杉樹陪伴小孩成長的習俗，樹木最終會成為他的棺木，下葬後再種一棵樹以作紀念，體現生命循環的信念。林健仁偏好以平面和童趣的手法創作圖案，以墨汁繪製黑白設計。他是次參與 Motifx 這項目的設計，亦是這個系列的延續。

Kinyan 在香港知專設計學院完成高級文憑課程，隨後前往英國升學，畢業後曾在德國實習。

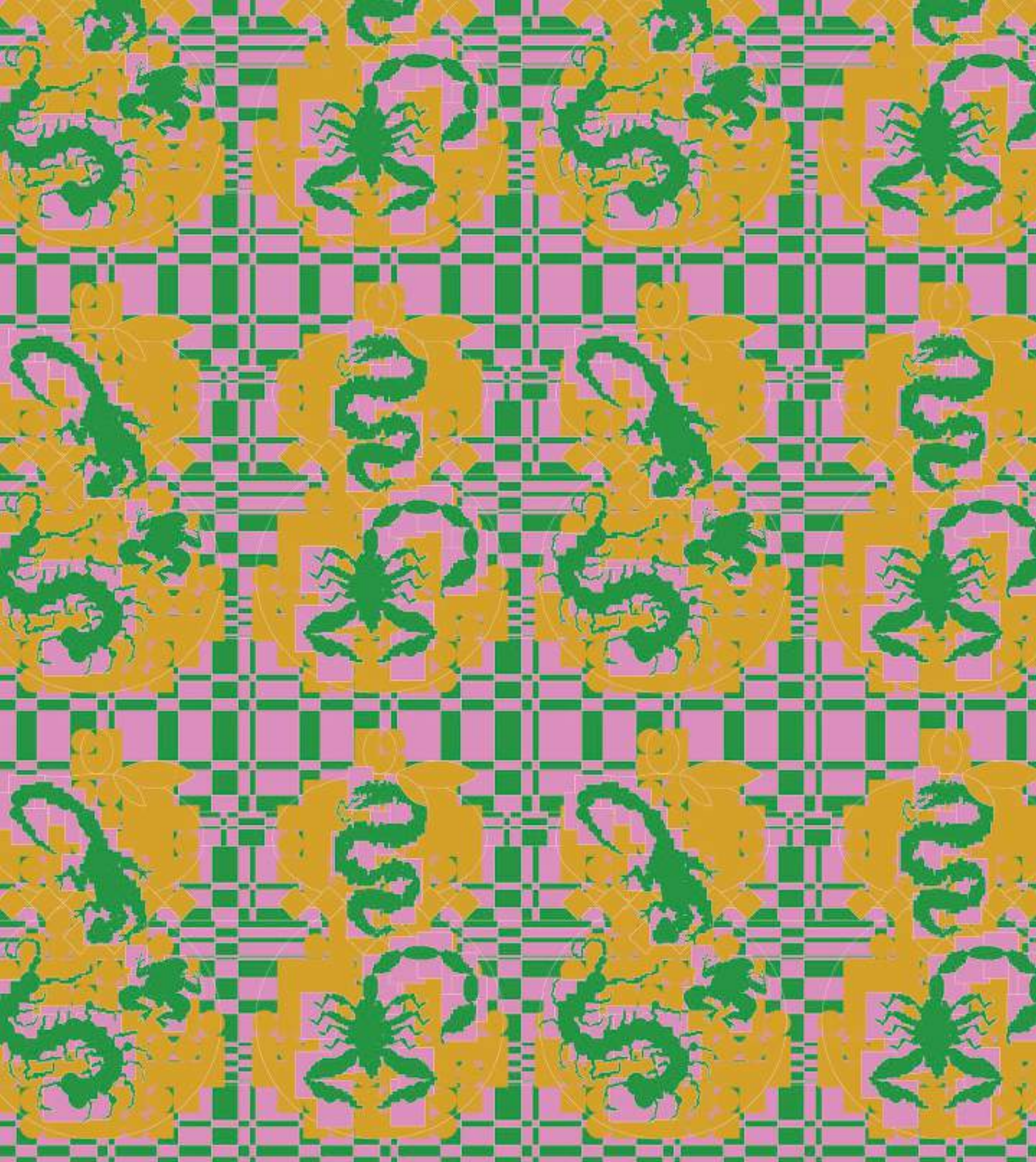
PERSONAL PROFILE 個人簡介

Tony Leung 梁浩明

Tony Leung has been a graphic designer for a decade. This project marks his first attempt to incorporate traditional Chinese graphic elements into modern design. He has rethought how to combine ancient wisdom with modern design language, aiming to strike a balance between tradition and innovation. The result demonstrates the infinite possibilities of cultural heritage in contemporary design, a notable departure from his previous work.

The series of works submitted for the Motifx project explores the potential for reinterpreting traditional patterns in the digital age. In particular, he highlighted a design based on the cloud pattern, where the traditional cloud pattern is transformed into a contemporary reinterpretation of the binary code “0101” in the digital realm. The design was inspired by the observation of an interesting connection between modern cloud technology and traditional Chinese cloud patterns.

Despite limited familiarity with traditional Chinese cultural elements in the past, Tony found that traditional patterns and culture proved a valuable source of design inspiration through this creative experience. He believes it is important to continue learning and staying connected with traditional Chinese culture, and that this experience has opened up a new creative direction for him, with the potential for further exploration of the modern interpretation of traditional elements in his personal works in the future.

從事平面設計已有十年的梁浩明（Tony Leung），這次首次嘗試將中國傳統圖案元素融入現代設計中。他重新思考如何將古老智慧與現代設計語言結合，在傳統與創新之間找到平衡，展現文化傳承在當代設計中的無限可能，這與他過往的工作風格有很大不同。

在他的 Motifx 項目提交的系列作品中，Tony 探討了如何在數碼時代重新詮釋傳統圖案。他特別提到了一個以雲紋為主題的設計，正是將傳統雲紋圖案轉化成數碼世界裡二進制代碼「0101」的現代演繹。這個設計靈感來自於他對現代雲端技術與中國傳統雲紋之間有趣連結的觀察。

雖然過去較少接觸中國傳統文化元素，但通過這次創作經驗，Tony 發現傳統圖案和文化是設計靈感的寶貴來源。他認為持續學習和接觸中國傳統文化是十分有意義的，並表示這次的經驗為他開啟了新的創作方向，未來可能會在個人作品中繼續探索傳統元素的現代演繹。

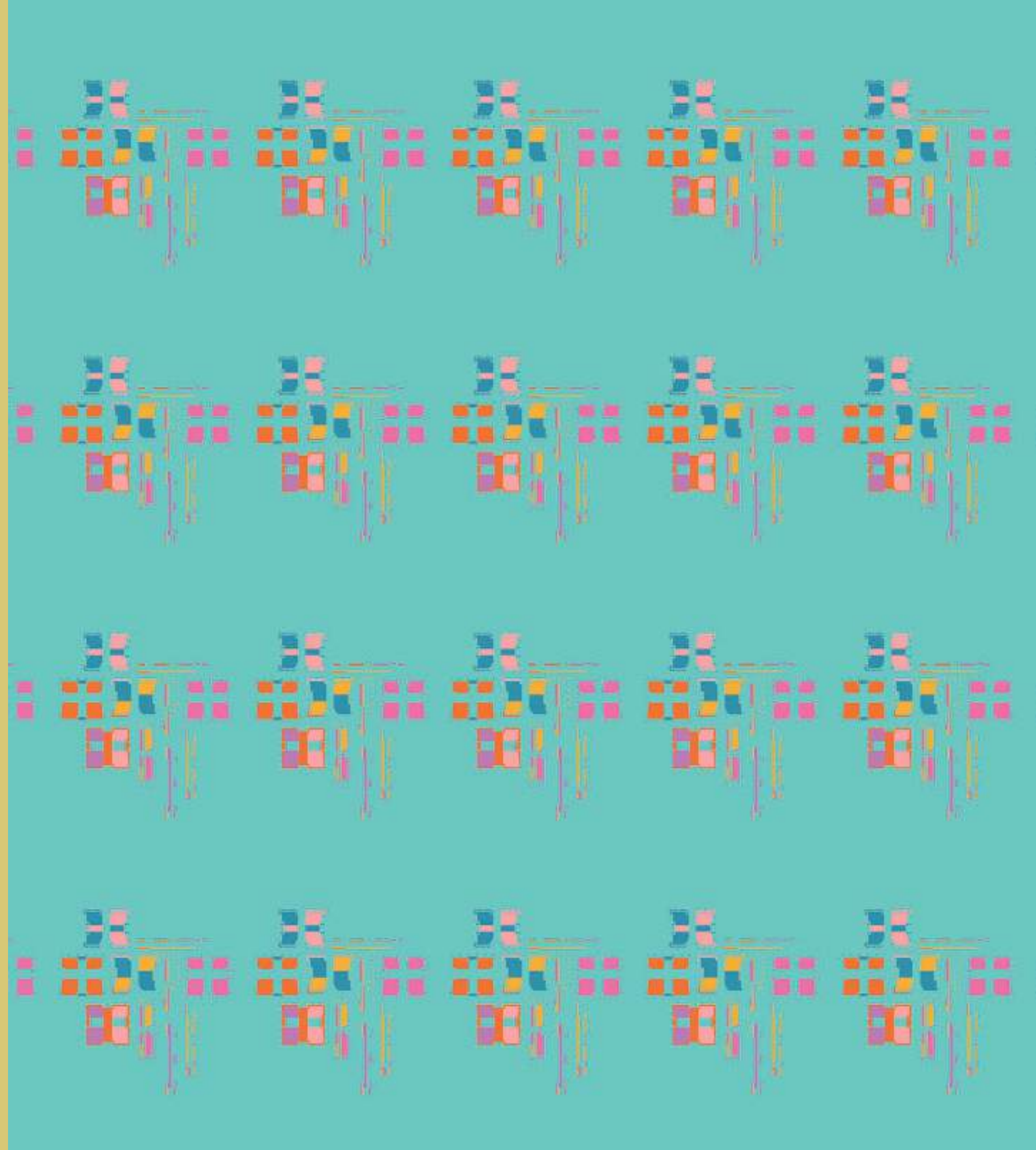
